We were unable to come up with a nominating committee for officers for 2006. Bruce Kern reminded everyone that the offices of President, Secretary, Treasurer and Newsletter Editor are all open offices.

The older riding lawn mower has some problems that need to be fixed. It was decided to call Ross Ely and ask him to repair the mower and bill the club for parts.

Ron Henderson won the 50/50 drawing and there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:37 P.M.

November 2005 Meeting Minutes

Mike Behl called the November meeting of Sangamon Valley Rc Flyers to order at 7:00 p.m. with eight members present. First order of business was to have the secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting. Bruce Kern that task and the minutes were approved as read by the membership present.

There was no further discussion after that and the meeting was
