New Business

A brief discussion was held about the RC equipment of the late George Bailey. A suggestion was made to have another list of items, including prices. Nothing was decided at the meeting.

Bruce Kern announced that he and Tim Tavernor were working on a new roster of members. He suggested that anyone that had changes in their personal info, including e-mail addresses and radio frequencies, let him know so an updated roster can be published.

Ron Henderson reported that the porta-potties had been treated and the company left some of the treatment fluid that could be added next spring.

Bruce Kern asked the club members if the Sangamon Valley Flyers could host an IMAC contest in 2005. After an extended discussion, Bruce Kern was appointed to check with IMAC to see if there were any open dates and report at the next meeting. Bruce Kern also suggested that we start a Christmas Party again. After a brief discussion, Mike Behl suggested we could even have it in January since it is our first for a while. We took a vote and had twelve people interested. A committee was formed to investigate where it could be held and is to report at the December meeting.
