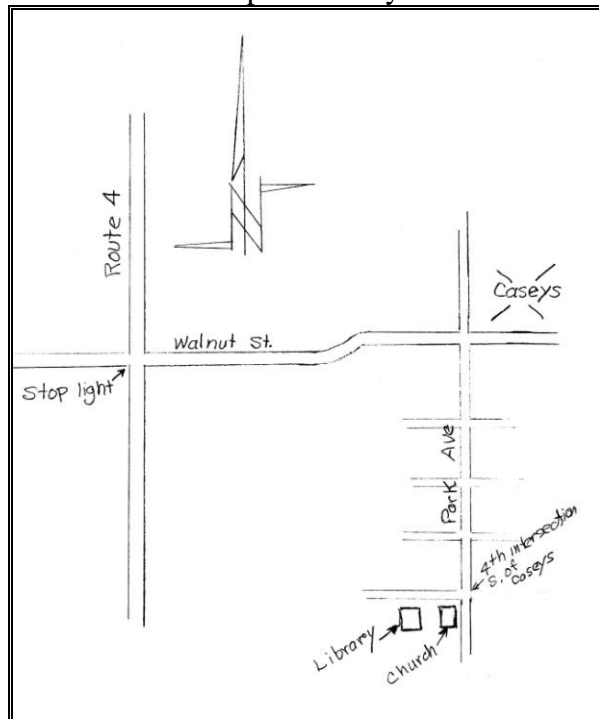


Jim England's trainer with good Fox 40. Aluminum landing gear with large wheels. No radio, but has one servo for ailerons.
